

## Over 300 Registered For 2008 Jacksonville Kayak Fishing Classic

JACKSONVILLE, FL - April 7, 2008 – The Jacksonville Kayak Fishing Classic is shaping up to be the world's largest kayak fishing tournament once again with over 305 anglers already registered for the May 2-3 event.
